## 2 Safety Information



Read this information before using your mobile device otherwise may result in personal injury or your device not complying with local laws.

### **Battery:**

If a conductive material such touches the exposed terminal, short circuit may occur resulting in property damage, bodily injury or burn. To avoid risk of leaking electricity, take care when handling a charged battery particularly when placing it inside your pocket, purse or other container with metal objects.

### **Keep your mobile device from water:**

Keep your mobile device dry.

### **Use while driving**

Always obey the laws and regulations on the use of mobile devices in the area where you drive. Pay full attention to driving on the road. Use hand-free operation or earpiece if a call is needed.

### **Aircraft**

Mobile device may cause harmful interference so turn off your mobile device before boarding an airplane.

For safety consideration, you can make preventative measures such as set PIN Code for your SIM card to prevent other persons using your SIM card without your permission.

**Keep away from children**

Keep the phone, battery and charger away from children to avoid any personal injury.

## 3 Use and Care

To take care for this mobile device, keep it away from:



### Any kind of fluid

Keep the device away from water, rain, humidity, sweat or other moisture.



### Extreme heat or cold

Avoid the temperature below  $-10^{\circ}\text{C}/14^{\circ}\text{F}$  or above  $45^{\circ}\text{C}/113^{\circ}\text{F}$ .



### Microwave

Don't try to dry your phone in a microwave oven.



### Dust and dirt

Don't expose your phone to dust, dirt, sand, food or other inappropriate materials.



### Cleaning solutions

Use only a dry soft cloth to clean your phone. Don't use alcohol or other cleaning solutions.



### Ground

Don't drop your phone.

## 4 Essential

### 4.1 Power On/Off

**ON:** To turn on your phone, press and hold the power on/off key for two seconds.

**OFF:** To turn off your phone, press and hold the power on/off key for two seconds.

**Note:** Please follow the restriction of airplane and hospital. If you don't need network, you can select flight mode.

### 4.2 SIM and Battery Installation

Firstly, please turn off your mobile phone and disconnect it with charger before removing the battery.

Secondly, press and jog the battery door let it glide to the top of the phone, then make the battery door open.

Thirdly, insert the SIM card into the card slot. Please insert the SIM card with the right direction of golden touch spot.

Fourthly, insert the battery.

Finally, press power-on Key for turning the phone on.

### 4.3 Battery Charging

New batteries are not fully charged. Open the protective cover on your phone's accessory connector port, then insert the battery charger plug into the accessory connector port on the side of your phone as shown, and plug the other end into an electrical outlet. Your phone might require several hours to charge fully. When your phone is power off, it might take a few seconds

to show charging display and it shows charge complete when finished. When your phone is power on, the battery icon flickers when it starting charging and become still with full bars in battery icon when finished. If your battery is lower than 25%, MB-6900 will alarm with battery icon shown on the screen. If really too low, mobile phone will be turned off.

### **Battery Tips**

Battery life depends on the network, signal strength, temperature, and accessories you use.

Always use Original batteries and chargers. The warranty does not cover damage caused by non-original batteries, charger and/or accessories.

New batteries or batteries stored for a long time may take more time to charge

When charging your battery, keep it near room temperature.

When storing your battery, keep it uncharged in a cool, dark, dry place.

Never expose batteries to temperatures below -10°C (14°F) or above 45°C (113°F).

Always take your phone with you when you leave your vehicle.

It is normal for batteries to gradually wear down and require longer charging times. If you notice a change in your battery life, it is probably time to purchase a new battery.

Never dispose of batteries in a fire because they may explode.

## **4.4 Charge Battery via Charger**

Firstly, connect the data cable with the charger.

Secondly, connect cable end with the multifunctional jack of MB-6900. If the charger was plugged incorrectly, then your MB-6900 may be damaged. So please be careful for this step.

Thirdly, plug the charger into the socket. You can use the mobile phone when charging battery, but the battery charging time will be longer. When the mobile phone is charging battery, the touch screen may be not so sensitive because of unstable battery volume. So you'd better use mobile phone without being charged. Mobile phone will get hot when being charged. It is normal and will not affect the service life of mobile phone.

Finally, when the battery icon stop flickering, i.e., it is charged to full status, please stop the connection between the charger and mobile phone. Then pull out it from the power socket. Please do not remove the battery before removing the charger. Otherwise the mobile phone maybe damaged. Please note that first charging process may need 4 hours or up. Battery is a kind of consumable item, so it will wear down after a long time. The primary battery time is 1450 MAH.

## **4.5 Charge Battery via Computer**

Firstly, please turn on your computer before charging battery.

Secondly, please connect cable end with the multifunctional jack of MB-6900.

Thirdly, plug the charger into USB port of computer. Please wait a while before charging battery.

The waiting time for different data cables is subject to the cable type supported by computer.

Finally, when the battery icon stop flickering, i.e., it is charged to full status, please stop the connection between the computer and mobile phone. Then pull out it from the computer.

## **4.6 Memory Card**

MB-6900 supports FAT only. If you insert memory cards of other format, MB-6900 will prompt you to format the memory card. Frequent writing and data deleting will shorten the service life of memory card. If you insert a memory card, then the catalogs of file will be shown on the folder of /mnt/sdcard.

Firstly, press and jog the battery door let it glide to the top of the phone, then make the battery door open.

Secondly, insert memory card into the card slot with the right direction of golden touch spot.

Thirdly, fix the position of memory card with caging.

Finally, close the battery door.

## 4.7 Remove Memory Card

Before removing memory card, please unload it for safety concern.

The step is:

Firstly, select settings→ SD card & phone storage→ Unmount SD card→ Make power-off when standby.

Secondly, remove the battery door,

Thirdly, press and move the memory card.

Fourthly, take the memory card out of the slot.

Finally, install the battery door.

Note: Please do not remove the memory card when you are using MB-6900, otherwise the data may get loss or the phone may be damaged. .

## 4.8 Format Memory Card

If you format memory card on the computer, memory card and mobile phone will not be compatible. So please just format memory card on mobile phone. In standby status, please select settings→ SD card & phone storage→ Unmount SD card→ Format the SD card→ Format SD card.

Note: Please copy all important data to MB-6900 first. Please note that the manufacture does not guarantee for data loss of user mistakes.

## 5 Elementary Operation

### 5.1 Calibrate when using for the first time






































Click the white point of screen and make calibration.

## 5.4 MB-6900 Touch Screen

The following notes help you to use MB-6900 easily.

1. Please do not use sharp tools to scratch the touch screen.
2. Please do not use the touch screen to touch other electronic devices because the electrostatic discharge would make the touch screen running failure.
3. Please do not use the touch screen to touch water because humid environment may interfere the working of touch screen thus may be making failure.
4. You can use your fingertip to touch the screen. Please do not use fountain pen to operate on the screen. Use stylus carefully, don't force too much on the screen.
5. If the touch screen has offset, please make manual calibration first.

### **Basic Usage of Touch Screen:**

1. Point Holding : Hold a program about 2 seconds, and then you can open the program.
2. Rolling : Click and then roll 4 directions for moving the program.
3. Drag : Drag a program and you can move it.
4. Double click : When you need to view pictures or webpage, please double click twice for zooming in/ out.
5. If you do not use the phone for a specified length of time, the touch screen function will be turned off. If you want to use touch screen again, please press physical keys except for volume control key.
6. Backlight can be also adjusted. Click the menu of Settings when standby and then select Display→ Screen Timeout→ Time. If you want to lock, then press Power key.

## 5.5 Standby Key Lock Operation



Drag the icon to the right direction for unlocking the screen.



Sound mode is open when MB-6900 is in standby status. If you drag to the right

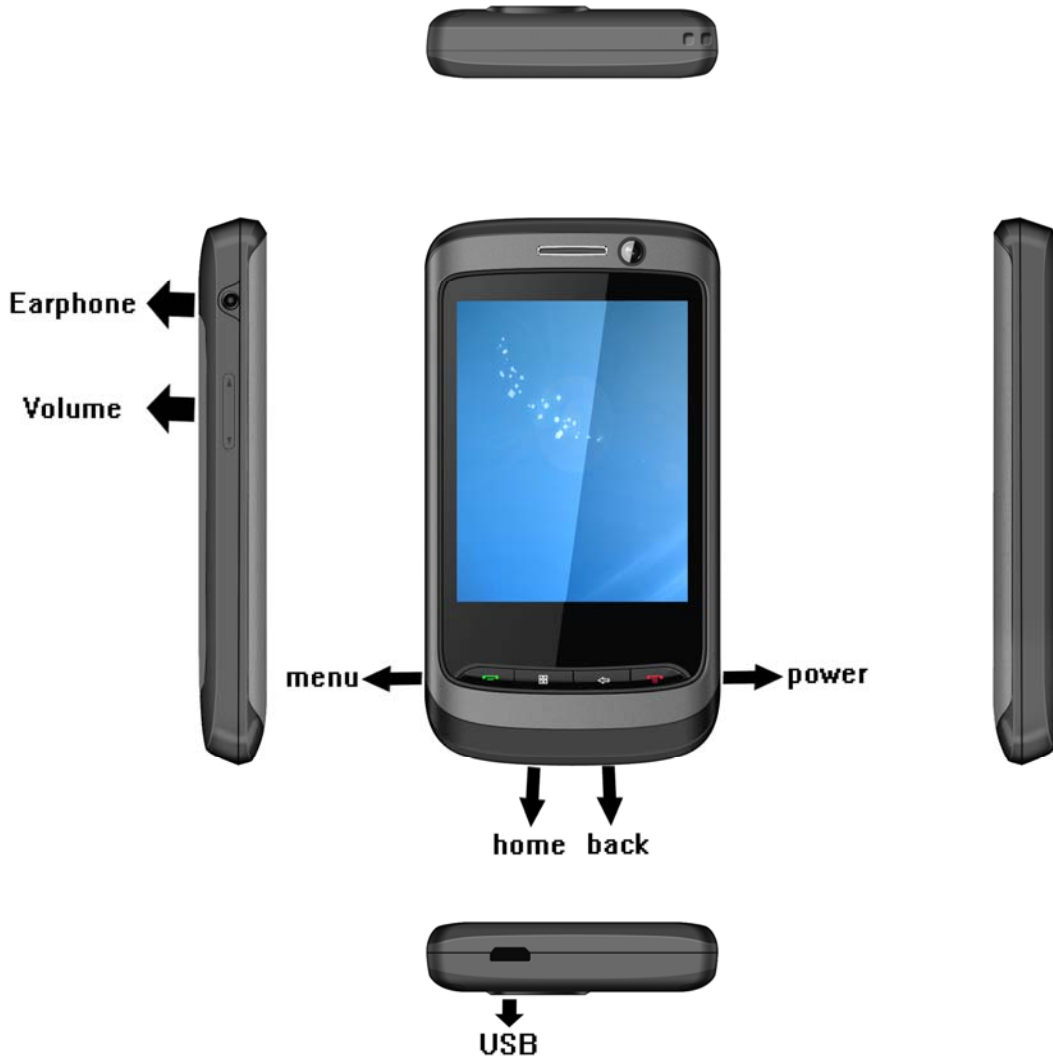
direction, then the sound icon will be transformed to the icon of vibration.



If the function of vibration is off, then you will see this Silent icon.



## 5.6 Slot & Physical Keys



Press Menu key for opening programs.

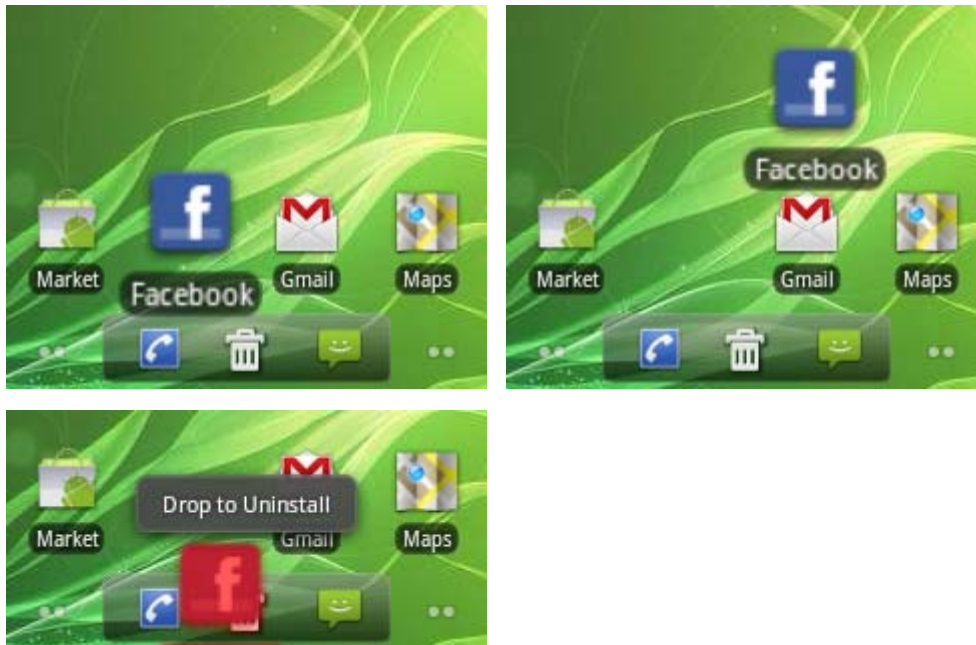
Press Home can return to the desk.

Press Back for returning to the previous page.


Press Power for locking MB-6900 or turning on/off.

## 5.7 Visit Programs and Edit Icons

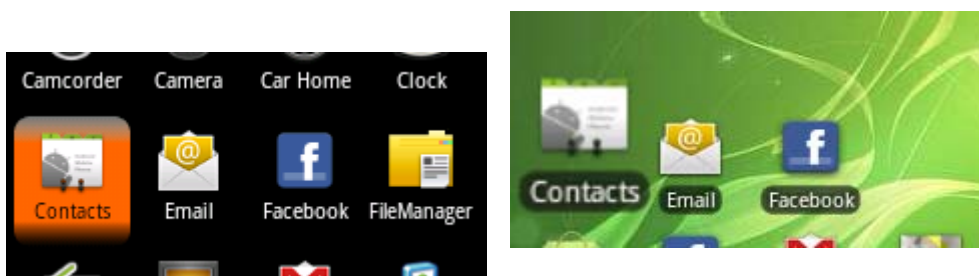
Press an icon on the screen, when it is zoomed in, please drag it. If you want to delete, just drag the icon into the rubbish bin.



### Steps of Visiting Programs:

- 1 Select this icon  for entering the list of application programs under standby mode.
- 2 Please roll left or right for selecting other programs.
- 3 Please select programs.

Tips: You can press the program for adding shortcut. You can move the icon to the place you need as the following picture shows.



4 Press Return Key (Physical Key) and back to the previous page. Press Home and return to the screen of standby.

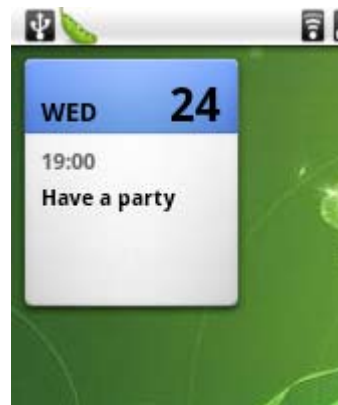
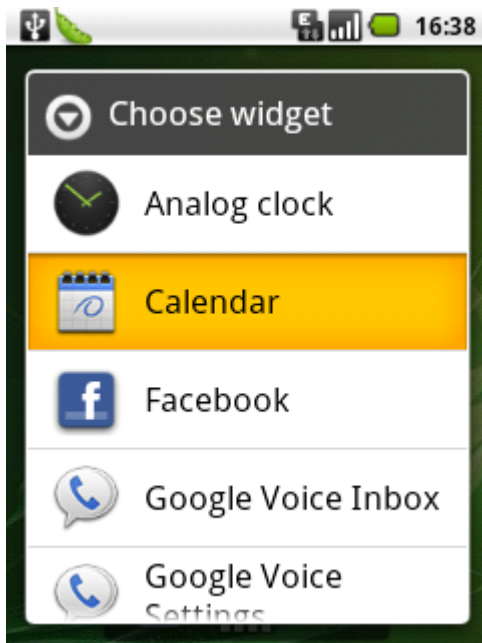
5 We have adopted built-in sensor into MB-6900. The screen can be shown in rotate mode

automatically. If you don't want it to be rotated, please change settings from Settings→ Display→ Auto-rotate Screen.

## 5.8 Adding Widgets



Please press Menu key and select Add for adding widget.



Please select Widget→ Calendar until you have the widget of Calendar.

## 5.9 Synchronizing with Your Google Account

Enter Settings→Accounts & sync→Background data, and tick√

Click Add account→Google→Next→Sign in, and then use your Google account to sign in. If you don't have Google account, please select Create, and the mailbox should be suffixed with **@gmail.com**

If you want to synchronize with your account automatically, please tick √ Auto sync.

Question: Why synchronize with Google account ?

Answer: Because Android mobile phones have connections with Google mailbox. If you don't add your Google account, then you cannot enter the function of Calendar.

Applications concerned : Calendar, Gmail, Contacts, Maps, Navigation, Market, Talk and Voice.

Remark : One mobile phone can add many Google account. If you want to delete the first account, please restore the factory settings.

## 6 Basic Function Settings

### 6.1 Application Programs

MB-6900 equips with multi-functions with supporting various application programs. Please be careful for running too many tasks at the same time in case of call interruption, system halt, storage problem, etc. You can use task manager for finishing unnecessary programs.

1 When in standby mode, press menu for entering settings → Manage applications. Then all running programs will be listed.

2 If you want to close a certain program forcibly, please select Force stop.

3 If you want to delete a program, find it in the list and select Uninstall.

4 If you want to install application program, search in Market and then install. You can also click the API file which is stored in File Manager ( Remark : Enter Settings → Unknown sources, tick it ✓ )

As for some other programs, you can select Move to SD Card for saving ROM space.

### 6.2 Current Time & Date

1 When in standby mode, please press Menu and select settings → Date & time.

2 You can set time and date or other functions. You can tick on Automatic for achieving time of local network automatically.

Remark : If set time manually, please make sure you set according to the correct time zone.

Otherwise some functions may be influenced.

## 6.3 Sound On or Off

- 1 When in standby mode, press Menu and select Settings → Sound.
- 2 Select the menu below Feedback.



## 6.4 Ring Tone

You can press the side key for adjusting ring tone.

You can also enter settings → Sound → Volume for the adjustment.

## 6.5 Silent Mode

If you want to run the mode of Silent, please follow the steps below:

- 1 When in standby mode, press Menu, enter Settings → Sound → Tick  under the menu of Silent Mode
- 2 When in standby mode, press Power key and select Silent mode.
- 3 If the screen is locked. Please slide the icon to left side. 

## 6.6 Ring Tone

- 1 When in standby mode, press Menu and then follow Settings → Sound → Phone Ring Tone.
- 2 You can enter Ring Tone and select Confirm.
- 3 If you need to add your songs, please select one song in the music. Press Menu and select Use as Ring Tone.

## 6.7 Animation

- 1 When in standby mode, press Menu and then follow Settings → Display → Animation
- 2 Select one animation you need.

## 6.8 Wallpaper

- 1 When in standby mode, press Menu and then select Wallpaper.
- 2 Select pictures of static state.
- 3 Select Save or Set Wallpaper.
- 4 If you need live wallpaper, please just select Live Wallpapers. Live wallpaper is defaulted by the system. If you want to add new one, please download from the menu of Market or other means yourself.

## 6.9 Screen Brightness

- 1 When in standby mode, press Menu and then follow Settings → Display → Brightness
- 2 Drag and slide to the level of brightness.
- 3 Select OK.

**Remark:** The brightness of screen will influence the battery consumption of mobile phone.

## 6.10 Screen Lock

You can lock MB-6900 for privacy concern. After locking the screen, you will be asked to input the password each time turning on and unlocking the mobile phone.

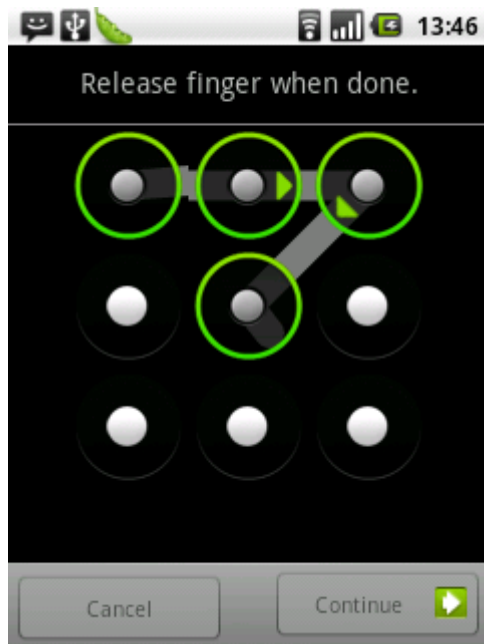
If you forget your password, please take the phone to our service center. We will not be responsible for the loss of safety code& private document caused by the use of illegal software.

## Screen Lock Pictures

1 When in standby mode, press Menu and then follow Settings → Location & Security → Set Up Screen Lock → Pattern

2 Please pay attention to the prompts and samples for your selection.

3 Drag at least 4 points and draw a picture.



4 Select Continue.

5 Draw picture again and confirm.

### A. PIN Setting for Phone Lock

1 When in standby mode, press Menu and then follow Settings → Location & Security → Set Up Screen Lock → Pin

2 Input new PIN and continue

3 Input again and confirm

### B. PIN Setting for Phone Lock

1 When in standby mode, press Menu and then follow Settings → location & security → set up screen lock → password

2 Set new password and continue

3 Input again and confirm

**Remark:** A and B pin settings are for the use of locking phone. You can select either A or B. If you lose your password, please turn to our service center.

### **C. PIN Setting for SIM or USIM Card**

1 When in standby mode, press Menu and then follow Settings → Location & Security → Set up SIM Card Lock

2 Input your PIN and confirm

#### **Remarks:**

1 If you have set PIN, then you need to input PIN each time when you turn on the mobile phone.

2 If you input PIN incorrectly, then your SIM or USIM card will be locked. Then you need to input PUK for unlocking SIM or USIM card. If PUK is input incorrectly as well, your SIM or USIM will be locked. Then you need to turn to your service provider for unlocking.

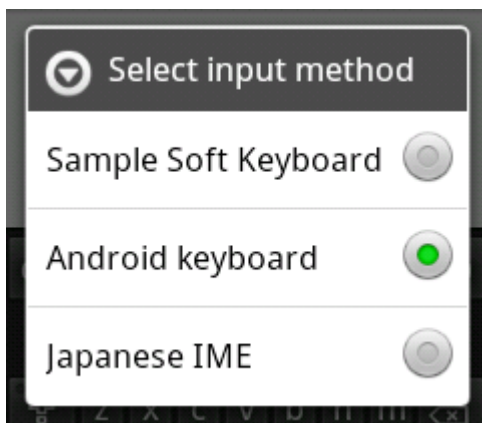
# 7 Input Method & Text Editing

## 7.1 Change Input Method

1 Go to the following text box.



2 Select Input Method



3 Select the Input Method you need.

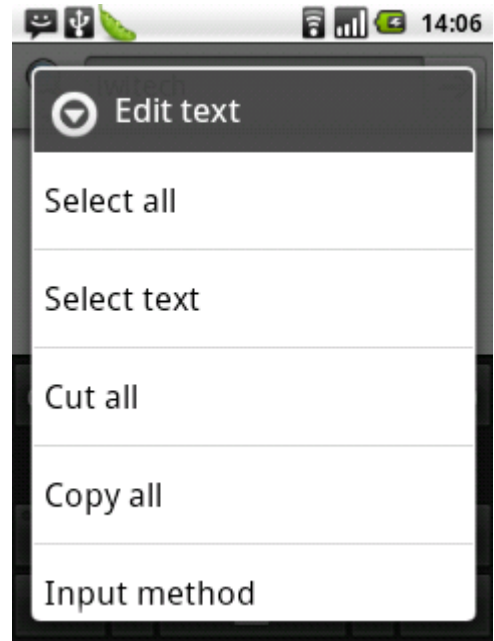
If you want to use the input method you installed or changing the input method, please press Menu and then follow Settings → Language & keyboard → Select the input method you need

and tick when in standby mode.

## 7.2 Copy and Paste Text

When you input contents for your text, you can take good advantage of the function of copy & paste.

- 1 Please put the cursor into the start position you need.
- 2 Click the text and input your contents.
- 3 Select the text from the list shown on the right side.
- 4 Click the end position.
- 5 Drag the highlighted content.
- 6 Select Copy or Cut for pasting the text into clipboard.
- 7 Drag the text and you can paste to another program.
- 8 Select Paste for pasting the text from clipboard to the text of another program.



## 8 Call Function

### 8.1 Dial and Receive Call

You can use the touch screen for realizing the call function.

When in standby mode, select phone icon  → Dial numbers, and input district code and mobile phone number.

If you want to end the call, please press Menu and then select End Call.

You can also press Power Key for ending the call immediately. You can follow Settings → Accessibility → Tick  Power Button Ends Call

You can call numbers via other menus, such as Call Log, Contacts,

If you want to visit the call logs, please select the latest number of call logs. Please follow Phone → Call Log

### 8.2 Answer a Call

1 When there is a call comes, please drag the icon to the right direction and unlock it.



When the mobile phone rings, you can press side key volume for make it silent.

2 If you want to end the call, please press Menu and then select End Call.

You can also press Power Key for ending the call immediately. You can follow Settings → Accessibility → Tick  Power Button Ends call.

## 8.3 Reject a Call



When there is incoming calls, please drag the icon to the left direction and unlock it. Then you will hear busy line signal.

## 8.4 Dial International Call

1 When in standby mode, select the icon of Call, then you will enter the dial pad. Please follow the order of making international call: 00→ Country Code→ the Number you want to dial→ Press Dial Key.

## 8.5 Use Earphone

Please plug in the earphone, and then you can answer or end the call according to your needs. The attached earphone is just for MB-6900, which may not be compatible with other mobile phones or MP3 players.

## 8.6 Voice Call

You can use the following functions in voice call:

- 1 You can press volume side key up or down for adjusting the volume.
- 2 Slide Dial pad up is for opening the dial pad and slide down for closing.
- 3 If you need to dial one more call during a call, please press Menu→ Hold, and then Add Call.
- 4 If need the voice mute, please enter Menu and then press Silent.
- 5 If you need to open speaker, enter Menu→ Speaker.

**Remark:**

- 1 It may be hard to hear the voice if you open the speaker in a noisy environment.
- 2 You can also use blue tooth to finish a call by selecting Bluetooth function.
- 3 Please press Home for returning to the standby mode. Then you can shift the calls or open the status bar for your other needs.



## 8.7 Call Forwarding

Call forwarding works for sending calls to your designated number once you cannot receive the calls or out of call service.



- 1 When in standby mode, select Menu, enter Settings → Call settings → Call Forwarding
- 2 Select Always Forward/ Forward when busy/ Forward when unanswered/ Forward when unread according to your needs.
- 3 Input the number of forwarding and make it enable. Done.

# 9 Message

## 9.1 SMS

- 1 When in standby mode, select the icon of message  → new message.
- 2 Then select a number. There are 2 ways to input numbers, one is: Input numbers in the blank column; The other one is: you can also select the icon near the blank column. 
- 3 Type to compose the contents you want. If you need to insert Smiley, press Menu and then Insert smiley.
- 4 Select Send then your SMS will be sent.

## 9.2 MMS

- 1 When in standby mode, select the icon of message  → new message.
- 2 Then select a number. There are 2 ways to input numbers, One is: Input numbers in the blank column; the other one is: you can also select the icon near the blank column. 
- 3 Press Menu and then Attach for attaching MMS. You can select attachment from your file manager in which stores photos, videos and sound files.
- 4 Press Menu and then Add Subject.
- 5 Select Send then your MMS will be sent.

## 9.3 View SMS/ MMS


- 1 When in standby mode, select SMS or MMS icon which specify different messages.
- 2 Select single SMS or MMS. You can slide the screen for viewing all history SMS or MMS.
- 3 If you are viewing MMS, please select the attachment.

# 10 Mailbox

## 10.1 Setup Email

- 1 When in standby mode, select Email after entering Home.
- 2 Input your email address and password, then press Next.
- 3 Select Next for setting up an email address, or Manual Setup. You can select POP3/IMAP/Exchange for your actual email server.
- 4 Please follow the prompts for your operation. After finishing the setup of email account, the information of your mailbox will be downloaded automatically to MB-6900. If you have built more than 2 accounts, you can shift between the accounts in this way: Menu→ Accounts, and then select an account you need.

## 10.2 Send Email

1 When in standby mode, open application program list according to the icon , then select Email→ Menu→ Accounts.

2 Press Menu and enter Compose.

3 Select an email address. You can input the email address manually.

If you need to CC your email to others, please press Menu and that enter Add CC/BCC.



4 As the picture above shows, please select the column of Subject and input subject of email.


5 Please select the column of Compose Mail for composing an email.

6 If you need to add attachment, please select Menu and enter Add Attachment.

6 Select Send for sending email.

## 10.3 View Email

When you open your email account, you can view the emails received last time, or checking new emails.

1 When in standby mode, open application program list according to the icon , then select Email→Accounts.

2 Press Menu and then Refresh.

3 Back to the mailbox for viewing emails.

## 10.4 About Gmail

Gmail is the specific email program of Google.


The difference of Gmail and other Email account is:

You can open your Email account as personal or company account. When you are using Gmail, you can only log in Google account and be connected with other programs of Google, such as Google calendar.

Method of logging in Gmail in MB-6900:

1 Please creat or log in your Google account first ( Please refer details to Content 5.9


Synchronizing with Your Google Account )

2 Open application program list according to the icon , then select Gmail. If you have logged in many Google accounts, then you can shift the account on the right top side of Gmail.

3 If your mailbox does not update email automatically, please press Menu and Refresh.

# 11 Camera

## 11.1 Take Pictures

1 When in standby mode, please open the application program list  and then select Camera.

2 Select the following icons for specific settings.



Zoom In/Out



Flash Mode



White Balance



Store Location



Picture Size




3 Press Shutter for taking pictures.

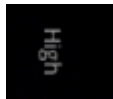
4 Press Menu, enter Gallery for viewing pictures.

The defaulted storage for pictures is: SD Card/ DCIM/ Camera

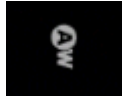
## 11.2 Camcorder

1 When in standby mode, please open the application program list  and then select Camcorder. You can also press Menu and enter Switch to Video if you are using camera.

2 Select the following icons for specific settings.



Video Quality



White Balance



Color Effect



3 Press the shutter of Camcorder for taking video.



4 Press the icon and stop taking video.


5 Press Menu, enter Gallery for viewing videos.

The defaulted storage for video is the same as that of pictures: SD Card/DCIM/Camera

# 12 Music

You can play music by entering Music. It supports the format of MP3 only.

## 12.1 Play Music

1 Open the application program list , slide to left side and then select Music.

2 Select Songs and make the following operations.



Now Playing



Shuffle Play



Repeating All Songs



Shift to Previous Songs



Pause



Shift to Next Songs

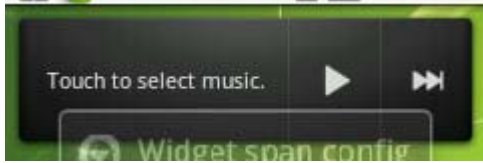
Songs can be background play. Press Home and then you could back to the standby screen for other operations.

If you are in standby screen but want to back to the music play screen, please just slide the status bar on the top and then select the ongoing music.

You can use the side key for adjusting the volume of music.

## 12.2 Add Music Widget


- 1 Press Menu in the standby screen, select Add → Widget → Music.
- 2 Select the size of Widget.
- 3 Drag the widget to the standby screen for turning on music quickly.



## 13 Gallery

You can view pictures or videos in Gallery. We suggest you use the format of JPG for pictures and 3GP & MP4 for videos.

### 13.1 View Pictures

1 When in standby mode, please open the application program list  and then select Gallery.

2 If you have many gallery and pictures, please slide the screen up and down for viewing and selecting.

3 You can zoom in and out the pictures by double click or using the icon below when viewing

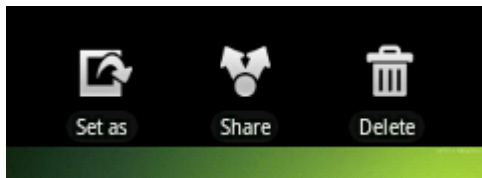
3 Please adjust the size of picture, press Save for saving the picture. Then when the person send message or call you, His/her icon will be shown on the screen.

If you want to add new window, then press Menu → New window.

Check current website windows, press Menu → Windows. Press one website then you can open one website. If you want to open other websites, please Menu → the website you need.

Refresh website: Press Menu → Refresh.

Forward website: Press Menu → Forward.

Make website as bookmark: Press Menu → Bookmarks.

Find key words of website: Press Menu → More → Find on page.


Copy text of website: Press Menu → More → Select text.



### Send Information

1 When in standby mode, please open the application program list  and then select File Manager → Select one file for sending → Share → Buletooth. You can also send the information from Gallery or Music.

2 Search device and wait for pairing.

### Receive Information

1 When in standby mode, please open the application program list  and then select menu,

follow the order: Settings→ Wireless & networks→ Bluetooth settings → Discoverable. There is only 120 seconds for discoverable process. If the bluetooth cannot find the mobile phone, you need to tick Discoverable again for renewing the discoverable process.


2 Input password if the connection requires and wait for pairing.

3 You will be prompted accept the file or not. You can select Accept or Decline for your needs.

The data will be downloaded in the file of Downloads / Bluetooth


# 18 WLAN

## Activate WLAN

1 When in standby mode, please open the application program list  and then select Menu. Follow the order: Settings→ Wireless & Networks → WIFI Settings → Tick WIFI.


2 Mobile phone will search WLAN automatically.

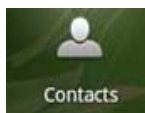

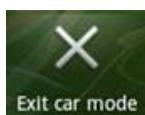

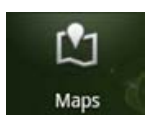

## 22 FM Radio

When in standby mode, please open the application program list  and then select FM Radio. Each time when you need to listen to FM Radio, please plug in earphone first.

## 23 Maps

### Activate the Function
